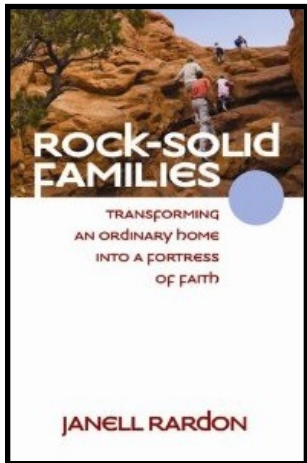




CRAFTING A MENDED HEART MISSION

5 INGREDIENTS FOR YOUR MENDED HEART MISSION:

1. Make Jesus Christ the focal point.
2. Make it short and sweet*. *The Mended Heart Mission in my blog expounds on my mission statement, "Practicing the Complexities of Love in Order to Help Hurting People."
3. Make it crystal clear.
4. Make it reasonable.
5. Make it reflect your God-given identity (inner and outer character qualities), capacity, potential, gifts and talents and passions and desires.

IN SUMMARY:

1. Make Christ the Focal Point.

As a follower of Christ, your primary mission is to glorify God. He is the axis upon which your life will rotate.

2. Make it short and sweet.

A rock-solid one-liner is just that. One line, no longer.

3. Make it crystal clear.

Use your own words: easy-to-understand, not flowery, not intellectual...just plain and simple.

4. Make it reasonable.

One of the wisest pieces of advice I even received was to set reasonable goals. I'm a dreamer. Big is better. Now obviously, there is a time to dream big...to see the larger picture, but in crafting this mission statement, think now. Don't set yourself up for failure. Example: "I will love everyone." (Unreasonable)

"I will practice love daily." (Reasonable)

5. Make it reflect God-given identity and capacities.

This takes introspection-looking to God and self and then praying and meditating on who you are and what you are here, on planet Earth, to express to the world.
